ave you you witnessed God doing anything different or unusual recently?" I asked the assembled leaders from one of our mature movements in Asia. They had shared testimonies of healing and miracles – regular occurrences for them - when my question caused them to pause. After some time, one of the younger leaders began to share:

"Every year when the rains come, the river jumps its banks, changing course and destroying villages in its path. The rains were particularly heavy in my area and people had little notice before they had

to flee their homes to escape the river's new path. Villagers in one location gathered at the mosque on the edge of the village, asking the imam to pray for the preservation of the village.

"After days of prayer, there was no change in the river's course. In fact, it inched higher and closer to the mosque which sat on the edge of village. On Friday, the village gathered at the mosque for what seemed certain to be their last meeting. Our followers of Isa al Masih were also there. Fueled by fear, some of the villages started taunting them saying, 'God didn't answer the imam's prayers, but you say God answers prayers offered in Isa's name. Prove it!' "Three of them answered, 'We will pray if you will believe that Isa can do this. But if you do not believe, you must agree to remain silent.' Curious, the villagers agreed and

the believers waded into the river, praying loudly, 'God Almighty, you see the shame we're enduring for your name's sake! We call on you to deliver our village and restore honor to us!' They prayed loudly for

about 20 minutes until the direction of the river started to change. But when they exited the river, the rain began to fall and the water levels started rising. In the morning, the village was still intact to the amazement of all. "In the days ahead, the water receded revealing a dike of dirt that had been pushed up in front of the mosque, protecting the whole village. The people changed their attitude toward Isa with many families putting their faith in him. The imam has requested copies of the Gospel and news of this miracle has spread throughout the area creating great openness."

In the following days I heard many more miracles in response to prayers in Jesus' name. As we probed the implications of these things for the movement, the leaders voiced one unanimous conclusion: "We need to print more Gospels as soon as possible. The need is large – and growing."
